A resume can make the difference between landing an interview and landing in the “no” pile. Students will learn to create or improve a resume for applying to their major, volunteer opportunities, internships, graduate school, and full or part-time employment.

The interview can cause anxiety, but being prepared lets the employer know you are the right candidate for the job. Learn interviewing essentials including answering difficult questions, types of interviews and strategies for successfully preparing.

The job search can be like looking for a needle in a hay stack and can leave one quickly frustrated. This presentation is for students preparing for their first full-time job search or who have been searching with little luck.
