Distinguished Alumni Award

Eligibility

1. Any alumnus/alumna from the College of Education and Human Development who has achieved great distinction for accomplishments in her or his own country or region.
2. Has received an M.A., M.Ed., Ed.D., or Ph.D. degree from a current unity of the University of Minnesota College of Education and Human Development.

Organization and Presentation of Supporting Materials

Nominees are evaluated on the basis of the documentation outlined below. This documentation should be collected and submitted by a faculty or staff member from the College and delivered to Terry Anderson at the main desk of the Dean's office (104 Burton).

Attention: Due to issues of cultural sensitivity, before making any contact with a potential nominee about a nomination, it will be helpful to speak to Christopher Johnstone (6-1936).

Supporting Materials Requested:

1. A statement by the nominator(s) of no more than five pages, presenting the full case for nomination. This statement should describe the nominee's full qualifications and should provide evidence of the nominee's unique international contributions.
2. Two supporting letters of recommendation.
3. A copy of the nominee's curriculum vita.

Selection:

Selection of the award winner will be made by the Director of International Initiatives and the College's Alumni Association upon the recommendation of a review panel, and will be awarded during International Education Week, 2008.
