Essential Qualifications:

- Currently licensed or eligible to be licensed as an LISW or an LICSW in Minnesota
- Three years minimum post-MSW social work practice experience in a health care setting

- Previous experience in a teaching/training role (e.g. training workshops, presentations, guest lectures in courses, etc.)
- Demonstrated experience in working with diverse populations and organizations

- Five years of social work practice experience in a health care or related setting
- Knowledge of metropolitan and state-wide social services, particularly those related to health care
- Ph.D. in social work or a related field
- Current license as LICSW

- Teach graduate social work classes primarily in the School's Health Disabilities and Aging concentration
- Carry and manage a full teaching load consistent with the CEHD workload guidelines with a significant portion of this work load in the evenings and on Saturdays
- Advise graduate students and serve on student committees as eligible
- Serve on School of Social Work, CEHD and University committees
- Implement emerging technology to support teaching as appropriate
