4. Several CEHD undergraduate scholarships grant preference for specific student populations. To be considered for these awards, applicants must include the final page of this application packet requesting confidential information.

2. A two-page, double-spaced statement, responding to the following questions (with your full name on the upper-right hand corner of each page):

**B. Looking ahead 10 years, how do you envision contributing to our increasingly diverse and global community as a professional and as a citizen?**

3. A current résumé that includes paid and volunteer professional experience and service. Please include names and contact information (including e-mail addresses) of two professional or academic references.
4. A copy of your University of Minnesota transcript. An unofficial transcript is acceptable (available through One Stop Student Services on the Web: <http://onestop.umn.edu/onestop>).
