<p>Administration (Bachelor’s Degree) Work in a leadership capacity in government agencies, non-profit organizations, and corporate businesses</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Program manager, coordinator, or director</i> • <i>Case manager</i> • <i>Advocate</i>
<p>Education (Bachelor’s Degree & Certification, Advanced Degree)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Certified Family Life Educator</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Empower families by recognizing family strengths and teaching new knowledge, skills, and abilities ○ Work in for-profit, non-profit human service agencies, extension, faith communities, the court system, the military • <i>Teaching in a formal educational setting</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ High schools: require licensure with additional requirements ○ 2-year colleges: a master’s degree is usually sufficient ○ 4-year colleges and universities: a Ph.D is required
<p>Research (Advanced Degree) Conduct research in a variety of employment settings including universities, local, state, or federal agencies, businesses, research institutes, advocacy organizations, or in the non-profit sector</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Professor</i> • <i>Researcher</i>
<p>Marriage and Family Therapy (Advanced Degree & Licensure) Marriage, couple, and family therapy is a distinct profession in which the family is the focus.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Marriage and Family Therapist</i>
<p>Child Life Specialist (Bachelor’s Degree & Certification) <i>Child Life Specialists</i> provide emotional support for families, and encourage optimum development of children facing a broad range of challenging experiences, particularly those related to healthcare and hospitalization</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Certified child life specialist</i>
<p>Social Work (Advanced Degree & Licensure) Work in government agencies, community centers, schools, hospitals, hospices, mental health clinics and career centers.
